## Items Completed to Date in September

In April 2025, our community approved a

### \$30 million capital referendum

to address facility needs throughout the Whitewater
Unified School District.
THIS WILL INCLUDE:



#### \$19.4 million for

WHS updates, including new and expanded Career and Technical Education (CTE) space, cafeteria and kitchen updates, auditorium equipment, and tennis court replacement.



#### \$7.9 million for

HVAC, electrical, and plumbing upgrades, new doors and windows, and parking lot improvements.



#### \$2.4 million for

new drop-off and pick-up areas at WMS, new security camera systems, and ADA requirements.
